GOVERNMENT SHUTDOWN ASSISTANCE

In response to the ongoing government shutdown,
Hooper City will temporarily waive late fees for
residents who have been directly affected. To be
eligible for this assistance, individuals must provide
official documentation verifying their employment
status, such as a letter or notice received at the time
of furlough or separation.

Documentation must be submitted to Hooper City
Hall for review and verification prior to the waiver
being applied.

ROADSIDE PARKING

As winter approaches, Hooper City reminds all
residents that parking on city streets is prohibited
during snowfall or when snow removal operations are
in progress. Vehicles parked on the roadway during
these times can obstruct snowplows and delay
efforts to keep streets safe and passable.





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Storm Water

Did you know storm drains don't go to a treatment plant?

In Hooper, storm drains flow straight to rivers and sloughs no filters, no cleaning. So when anything other than rainwater goes down a storm drain, it ends up in the environment where it can harm fish, wildlife, and even our drinking and irrigation water sources.

Why should you care?

Polluted water can affect recreation, property values, and public health. Keeping storm drains clean protects our community and saves money on cleanup later.

What's allowed?

Hooper City Code prohibits all non-stormwater discharges except for these:

- Water line flushing
- Air conditioning condensate
- Landscape irrigation
- Irrigation water
- Diverted stream flows
- Springs
- Rising ground waters
- Water from crawl space pumps
- Uncontaminated ground water infiltration
- Footing drains
- Uncontaminated pumped ground water
- Lawn watering runoff
- Discharges from potable water sources
- Individual residential car washing
- Foundation drains
- Flows from riparian habitats and wetlands
- Dechlorinated swimming pool discharges
- Residual street wash water
- Dechlorinated water reservoir discharges
- Emergency firefighting activity

Call Hooper City at (801) 732-1064. A crew will check it out and fix the problem.
Together, we can keep Hooper's water clean and safe.



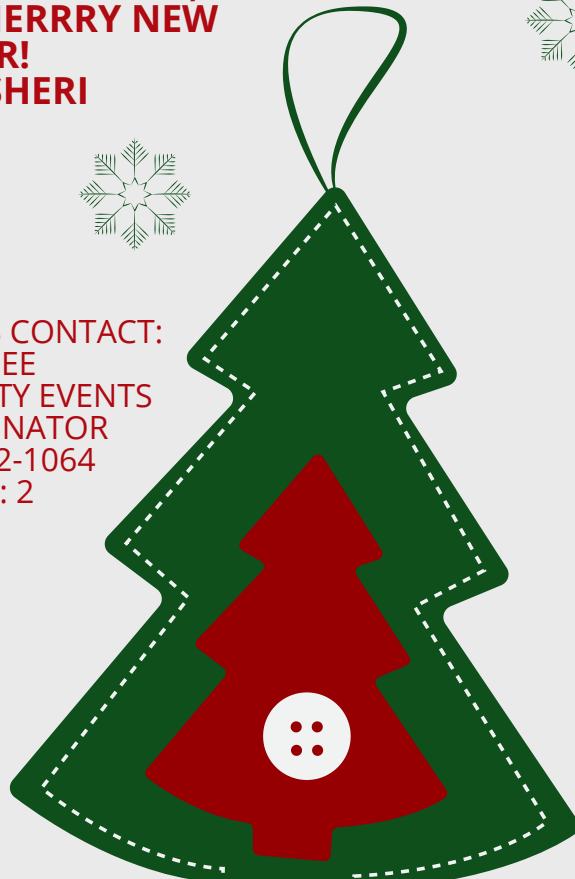

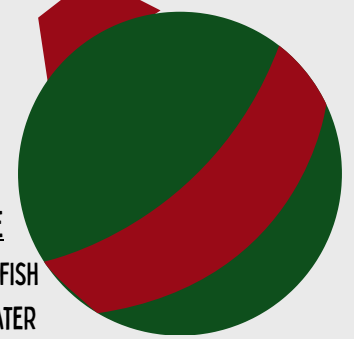
