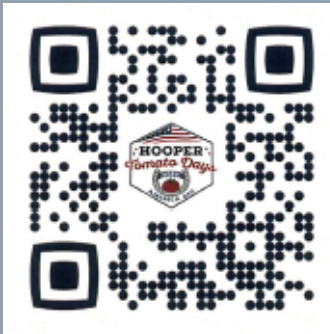

STORM WATER

Pet waste is more than a nuisance. It can carry harmful bacteria, viruses, and parasites that threaten people, pets, wildlife, and water quality.

When left on the ground, rain can wash these pollutants into rivers, lakes, and streams, where they can harm aquatic life. The solution is simple: pick it up, bag it, and throw it in the trash. Do not flush pet waste or compost it, as wastewater systems and compost piles are not designed to safely handle it. Proper disposal helps protect public health, keep waterways clean, and create a healthier environment for everyone.

SEWER

If you believe you have a clogged lateral or call a plumber or roofer service to clean or unclog your sewer lateral, IT IS IMPORTANT to contact the sewer department before utilizing those services. We are happy to work with your contractor to resolve the problem, but need to make sure it does not cause additional issues downstream. We have had problems where homeowners that have clogs in their portion of the system, hire plumbers or roofer companies and move the problem out to the city portion of the system that can cause equipment damage and or other residents to have a sewer backup that they may be liable for.
